Albania

We regularly support the **142 children from needy families at "Amaro Tan School** Recently there was a lack of sanitary products and, thanks to your donations, we could help. Sonja Geiger from "Amaro Tan School" made sure the donations were used accordingly. The school bought toilet paper, cleaning and washing agents, cutlery etc. and could therefore uphold a normal standard in the school. We have received a heartfelt letter of **thanks**.



Kenya With the help of the missionary Martin Lütjohann, we support children and young people.

Currently he has reported about a young girl, Chelatan, who has been helped "We are grateful for the assistance which means the girl can complete her schooling. We took her in at the age of 12. She was intended to be sold as a second wife to an older man as a "hunger bride". The proceeds were intended to help her parents through the dry season. In the meantime the contracts have been cancelled and Cheletan, who is a good scholar, is being prepared for a better future at the boarding school."

Uganda



We continue to support the nutrition unit of the mission hospital in Lira. The Göhner Family, who direct the hospital, write:: "Illness amongst children is terrible – but when they die of starvation, that is much worse. On this unit,

lives are saved!"
