Germany

In the district of **Rems-Murr** we continue to support the work of the "Tafelladen" in Winnenden in improving the quality of life for disadvantaged children. We have been able to help further with the provision of clothing, children's furniture, shoes etc. Now about 10 children need a new school bag and a "Schultüte" (school beginner's bag) for the primary school enrolment, in order for them to be on a par with their class peers. We have promised to provide these.

In **Freudenstadt** we support the successful work of "Eigensinn". Here, 140 children from families afflicted by addiction, divorce and violence problems receive excellent support. Life becomes meaningful for these children. In the past 15 years stories of sustainable success have been written!

The Philippines



We have received very good news from Carsten Aust about **JEVELIN**, the girl with blood poisoning and an infected leg (as reported here previously).

After five weeks in hospital, she has been released. She continues to need outpatient treatment and antibiotics. The wound is healing only very slowly, but one can nevertheless see signs of a good recovery. For us, this is an answer to prayer; without help she would have lost her leg, or even her life. Once more, **many thanks** for all gifts and prayers.

Mozambique

Life in Mozambique is hard for the majority of the young population – very hard. More than half of the population is younger than 18 years old, and every 6th person is an orphan. They did not experience the long civil war. One or both parents died due to AIDS, other illnesses or war. In the majority of cases, the children are raised by their grandparents or other members of their family. The aid organisation "PACO" helps these children. The missionary couple KIRNER does excellent work here, which we support.



The organisation, founded in 2008, does all it can to ensure that the children do not fall by the wayside regarding formal education.

In endangered families, the children have to work from an early age on. The fields have to be tilled so that there is something to eat at all. Children are therefore often not allowed to attend school. And consequently, from the beginning, it is certain that there will be no way out of poverty for these children in the future.

PACO helps such disadvantaged children!

In Chamanculo, a borough of the capital Maputo, 500 children are currently registered. The aid-workers visit the children regularly and ensure that they can go to school. This year, due to mediation between families and schools, 30 children who had already been denied access, were able to be enrolled in schools.

All the schoolchildren receive a school uniform and school material such as exercise books, pens and books from PACO. The obligatory school fee, which is due from year 8, is paid for by PACO for many of the children. In order to guarantee the support of these children in the long-term, a small farm is also run.

Here hens are bred and there is a plantation of citrus fruits, mangos, papayas and pineapples. The profits of the farming activities go directly into the work with the children. In this way the project becomes financially self-reliant, resulting in sustainable help for the children. The donations from our foundation are invested in the expansion of the farm, by which the long-term support of the children is bettered

Albania - Uganda

We regularly support the Amaro Tan School (Albania) – 142 children from needy families! The nutrition ward of the missionary hospital in Lira (Uganda) also needs our help to provide for the many children and orphans.
