The Philippines – Child poverty

We were visited by the missionary Carsten Aust and are appalled!



The poorest of the poor live in huts like these

The children of the approx. 20,000 poorest of the poor in Manila suffer **inconceivably**.

During the daily distribution of food, only the hungry children who are **undernourished** can be provided for. The children are weighed and only those who weigh less than the norm receive a voucher for food. **The means of the mission do not suffice for more.**

The "rubbish dump children" can no longer enter the dump to contribute to the family sustenance, as this has been closed in the meantime. Therefore the rubbish trucks waiting in the queue to be unloaded, have become the source of income for the poorest of the poor.

We are also encouraged, as the „House of Hope“ is making progress. There, children will be able to be housed and cared for permanently. These are abandoned children left in baby-flaps at hospitals, children from deserted huts or from the dumps. Very often, the mothers already have a lot of children and are simply unable to cope.

An employee has now been set on for this project. Now, certain equipment is required in order to obtain the operating permit. We have received a list of what is required. This list can be viewed on the webpage of our foundation:

Germany – First day at school

The **first day at school** began at the beginning of September. We were able to provide school satchels and school cones (goody- bags) for 5 children whose parents receive food provisions via the "Winnender Tafel".

The children now feel to be „on a par“ with their classmates, so we have been informed. This "start-up help" should be a motivation to pursue education. As a result, the children are not disadvantaged from day one. Above this, urgently required children's furniture, clothing and underwear has been provided.
