# The Philippines – Child Poverty

The orphanage "**House of Hope**" is running at full capacity. This is partly due to our contributions. Recently our donations have been used to supply a washing machine and for the clearance of a container with urgently required medication.

The results are impressive. Children are being rescued and given a foundation for leading their further lives positively. The challenge in the future is to financially support the orphanage and cover some of the costs for food, clothes and staff.

In addition to the orphanage, there is also a **kindergarten** and a **soup kitchen** for the "dump children". These facilities also require urgent aid.

A mountain school with a children's home for 60 children has also been established in the north of The Philippines for the native inhabitants. We will support this, in order to give these children a chance..





## Germany

For many years now, we have been providing school bags and "school cones" for socially disadvantaged children in the **district of "Rems-Murr**". By doing this, school does not begin with frustration or a disadvantage for these children.

The scout movement of independent Christian communities "Royal Rangers" came together for its national camp in Thuringia with more than 15000 participants. In two Christian communities, the necessary tents (yurts) could not be afforded. We helped out here and hence enabled many children to attend the camp.





# Romania

We have supported the initiative "Christmas parcel" of the aid organisation "hope for poor children in Romania". These Christmas parcels are delivered and distributed locally by voluntary workers.

Around 300 children have also been supplied with food and school materials via the organisation "Hands of Hope".

# Albania

The **Amaro Tan School** started the new school year with 130 children, consisting of 59 Romanies, 54 Egyptians und 17 Albanians. The school is financed purely by donations, giving fringe groups access to educational opportunities .
