The Philippines – Child poverty



We were visited by Carsten Aust, the leader of the **Children's and Orphans' aid in Manila**.

In 1997 a waste disposal site was closed. 18 years later, the conditions in the slums surrounding the former dump are unimaginable. Although everything is contaminated and the rubbish heap (**smoky mountain**) continues to smolder, the poorest of the poor live there.



The day care centre provides for the children there on a daily basis, and takes in discarded or neglected babies.

This work on the front line is unique and must continue to be supported.

In the **House of Hope** the annex has now been completed. It is encouraging to see the fruits this activity bears. Babies and children have been rescued and given the chance to lead a normal life.

So far, our support of the work of Carsten Aust amounts to more than 125.000 Euro.

Germany - Rems-Murr-District

More than **a million girls and boys** are growing up in poverty in our rich country. The main scarcities of these children are:

- No warm meal
- No room to do homework
- Only one pair of shoes
- Only worn-out clothes
- No internet access
- No leisure activities

By supporting the "Winnender Tafel" we help in the district of Rems-Murr. We have been able to help ease the deprivation of **170 children**.

We want to take this opportunity to heartily thank **Mr Hammer**, who has been responsible for allocating and supervising the resources (35.000 Euro) for 5 years. Due to age, he has assigned this work to **Mr Vogel**, who is now responsible for the daily work of the "Tafel".

Nepal – Earthquake Aid

Via the relief organisation AVC, we were able to directly help the **victims of the earthquake**. A worker in the region named Kaji, who has been looking after the orphans, reports about the destruction of the orphanage.

He's now living with the orphans outdoors.

We've been able to earmark resources specifically for the aid of the orphans and these funds have been passed on without any deductions whatsoever, and are being used for the **welfare of the children**.

Ukraine

A cry for help reached us from West Ukraine. 639 families arrived in Ushgorod and surrounding areas, following their flight from East Ukraine.

Although there is a high rate of poverty in this war-free area of Ukraine, these refugees have been received– including **20 orphans**.



Via Slawik, a worker in Gertrud Rothacker's orphan aid organisation, we can directly help the children. The monies are used by Slawik to buy groceries, medicine and clothing (shoes).

We will continue to help and do good.
